50 Years of Lay Preaching (Now 51!)

Way back in January 1966 in the Tewantin Methodist Church on the Sunshine Coast, Harry Thompson was presented with his Lay Preachers Certificate by the Reverend Robert Walker, Minister of the Noosa Methodist Circuit. Fifty years later, on 24 January 2016, a still very-youthful-looking Mr Walker accepted an invitation to join the Presbytery of Bremer Brisbane Chairperson, Reverend Brian Hoole, in presenting Harry with his Fifty Years Certificate as an Accredited Lay Preacher. The presentation formed part of a special service which takes place each year



in January before the new year's activities commence in the Oxley Uniting Church in Brisbane. Harry felt especially privileged as there are very few times in the life of the Church that the person who made the initial presentation fifty years ago is able to attend fifty years later to present the 50th Certificate. These days, Harry ponders on a Church that provides accredited Lay Preachers with very few opportunities to engage in a preaching ministry.

The Closing of the Darra Congregation and Commissioning of Pastor Dr Phuoc Dang

19th February 2017

The 19th February 2017 was a very special day in the life and history of the Uniting Church in Darra.

The first celebration was the formal closing of the Darra congregation that had been in existence for over 100 years. The congregation had been in recess for several years but it was time to formally close the congregation.

However, this closure opened the way for the property to be given formally to the Darra Vietnamese congregation that worship there. It is one of the few occasions where a CALD congregation has been given property with no strings attached and so this was an important occasion to celebrate.

The third and equally important event was the commissioning of Dr Phuoc Dang as the Pastor for the Darra Vietnamese people, having served his time within the Uniting Church before he could be commissioned.

It was a great day of celebration with Presbytery Chair (Rev Andrew Gunton) and Presbytery Minister (Rev Brian Hoole) both leading parts of the service.


























FROM MONIQUE COUGHLIN
